



General Environmental Requirements for Suppliers of products and Services that will not be marketed or resold by Saab

1 INTRODUCTION

The following environmental requirements are applicable to suppliers providing products and services (“Suppliers”) to Saab AB, or its subsidiaries, (“Saab”) that will not be used in products or systems that are marketed or resold by Saab.

2 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 The Supplier shall, as a minimum, comply with applicable environmental legislation and, where relevant, fulfil the requirements of ISO 14001. Formal certification is recommended and viewed as a merit during the supplier assessments.
- 2.2 The Supplier shall primarily offer Saab products and services that are eco-labelled. It shall also be the Supplier’s aim to replace any existing non-eco-labelled product with eco-labelled alternatives.
- 2.3 The Supplier shall provide information on whether the product is covered by any form of producer responsibility or other provisions that involve special handling on disposal. This may mean that the product shall be returned to the Supplier for end of life treatment.
- 2.4 Environmental charges linked to the product shall be included in the quoted price.

3 ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1 The product or service may be such that additional environmental requirements may be set. These shall be specified in the principal agreement and are applicable as a supplement to the requirements in this document. In the event of conflict between the requirements, the principal agreement shall be applied.

4 COMPLIANCE AND AUDIT

- 4.1 The Supplier shall, at the request of Saab, be able to show that the environmental requirements in this document and additional requirements are being fulfilled.
- 4.2 Compliance with the requirements may be checked by Saab at audits.
